“Colour your career”

A care leaver refers to a 'child/youth' that has been residing in alternative care and who is expected to leave alternative care when they are 18 years of age or when they have completed their academic career/reached their educational platform. Often these children in the Child and Youth Care Centers do not possess the necessary skills that are required to transition from childhood to adulthood effectively and are unable to create independent, successful lives for themselves outside of the center.

On the 28th of March, 24 care leavers of ENGO Child & Youth Care Centers will be attending a 10 day skills development program until the 9th of April 2018 to be held in Bloemfontein. This program will focus on equipping them with the necessary emotional skills needed for effective functioning outside of the center as well as a 5 day skills development training in their specific area of interest. 10 Youth Volunteers in a learnership program will also receive the opportunity for workplace experience.

ENGO Family Care Bloemfontein assists 700 school girls

Mpho Mokabeng and Magdeline Tshabalala, Social Auxiliary Workers at ENGO Family Care Bloemfontein identified a need within schools in the township and rural areas. The schools indicated that on a regular basis schoolgirls between 12-15 years, stay away from school during their menstrual cycle. The reason was simply because their families could not afford to buy them sanitary towels.

Our Social Workers and Social Auxiliary workers started raising money for the project. The amount of R4, 000 was raised for the buying of 13 boxes of sanitary towels for girls. Seven schools were targeted and 700 girls will benefit from the project.

Information sessions were held at the seven schools, educating the girls about what was happening to their bodies and that it is natural. The girls each received a packet of sanitary towels with a saving box. The saving box is to teach them to save what little money they may receive every month, to buy their own sanitary towels.



PLAKKIE PROJECT

ENGO Family Care, Welkom launched a fundraising event where school learners were asked to wear their sandals / "plakkie" for one specific day. On this day, our office gave a presentation to the school learners on the meaning of "plakkies" which relates to empowering school learners to have their own identity and to respect one another.

- A: Acceptance of yourself and others
- K: Look after yourself
- K: Look after other people
- L: Live in the moment
- E: Empathy and honesty

Vegetable garden project

On 14 March 2018 ENGO Family Care Welkom held a foster parents' session which focused on budgeting. Foster parents were encouraged to try and save money for the foster children in their care. This will enable the foster child to register at an university or for their drivers licence when they turn 18 years old.

Our office provided each foster parent with different vegetable seeds to start their own vegetable garden to assist with the family as the foster care grant is insufficient to provide for all the necessary basic needs of the child concerned.

Our office is planning to monitor the foster parents' vegetable gardens and to see how their vegetable garden is growing.

Thuthuzela Care Centre se slagsprek is "Turning victims into Survivors" dus het ENGO Gesinsorg Welkom hulle Kinderbeskerming Bewusmaking afskop om hoop te bring by Thuthuzela Care Centre se oorwinnaars.
